PARTNERSHIP PRINCIPLES

- A donor supports **capacity, not conclusions**. Partners never determine expert findings, data or methodology.
- Each partnership goes through conflict-of-interest screening and reputational review.
- Partnership does not mean political favour, endorsement or buying content.
- For larger private partnerships, FSF applies funding-source diversification rules; private sponsorship is internally capped at **25%** of FSF's total funding mix.
